David Lais is a social entrepreneur and the founder of several innovative start-ups in the area of payments. He started his first company at the age of 16 and by pure chance entered the payments industry. In 2015, a run in with the real-world impact of pollution and climate change shifted his perspective - and his career. That inspired him to contribute his expertise in payment technologies to promote conscious consumerism. As a result, he launched both the non-for-profit **Organisation for Conscious Consumerism** (OFCC) and co-founded ecolytiq, which leverages both open source and payments data to enable banks to contribute to a better world.

David strongly believes given the education and tools to live more conscious and environmentally responsible lives, consumers will lead the change. For David, technology and data are not a means to an end, but rather an indispensable tool in the global fight against the climate crisis.
